## Government

(Osage governance)

With the ratification of the Osage Nation Constitution in 2006 and the newly formed three-branch government system with executive, legislative, and judicial branches. The three branches are set up to limit each other's power through a series of restraints known as checks and balances.

Laws are enacted and funds are appropriated by the Legislative Branch consisting of 12 Congressional members who elect a Speaker and the Second Speaker.

Programs and day to day business of the Nation is administered under the Executive Branch through the Principal Chief, Assistant Principal Chief, staff members and program directors.

The Judicial Branch is responsible for interpreting the Constitution and laws of the Osage Nation.

The Osage Minerals Council is recognized by the Osage Nation Constitution as an independent agency within the Osage Nation established for the sole purpose of continuing its previous duties to administer and develop the Osage Mineral Estate in accordance with the Osage Allotment Act of June 28, 1906. The Osage Minerals Council consists of eight elected council members that serve as the administrative authority for the mineral affairs of the Osage Mineral Estate with a Chairman, Second Chair, and 6 council members.

The Osage Nation Judicial Branch is an independent, co-equal branch of the Osage Nation government empowered by the Osage Constitution to provide an impartial and responsive justice system that protects the rights and liberties of all who come before it, interprets and enforces governing law fairly and equally and reflects the unique social, governmental and cultural standards of the Osage Nation.

The Osage Nation Judicial Branch is committed to serving the Osage Nation, its members, and its community by providing a fair and efficient system of justice that offers all interested persons a meaningful opportunity to resolve disputes arising under the laws and regulations of the Osage Nation.

The Judicial powers of the Osage Nation are vested in one Supreme Court and a Trial Court.

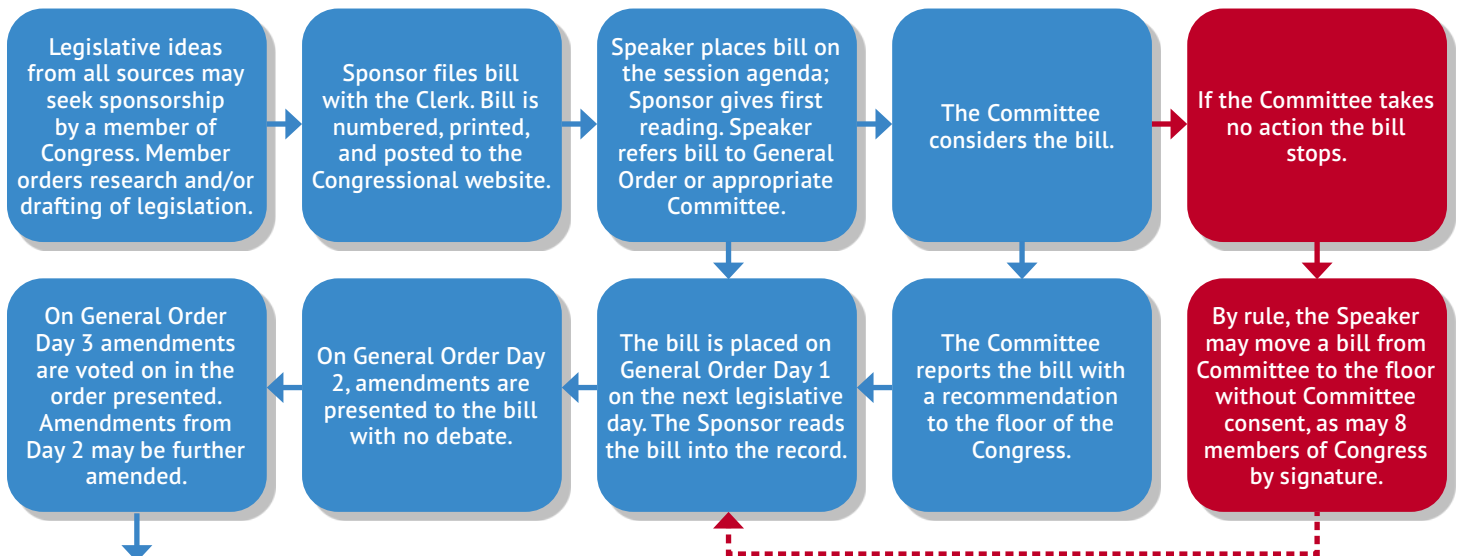

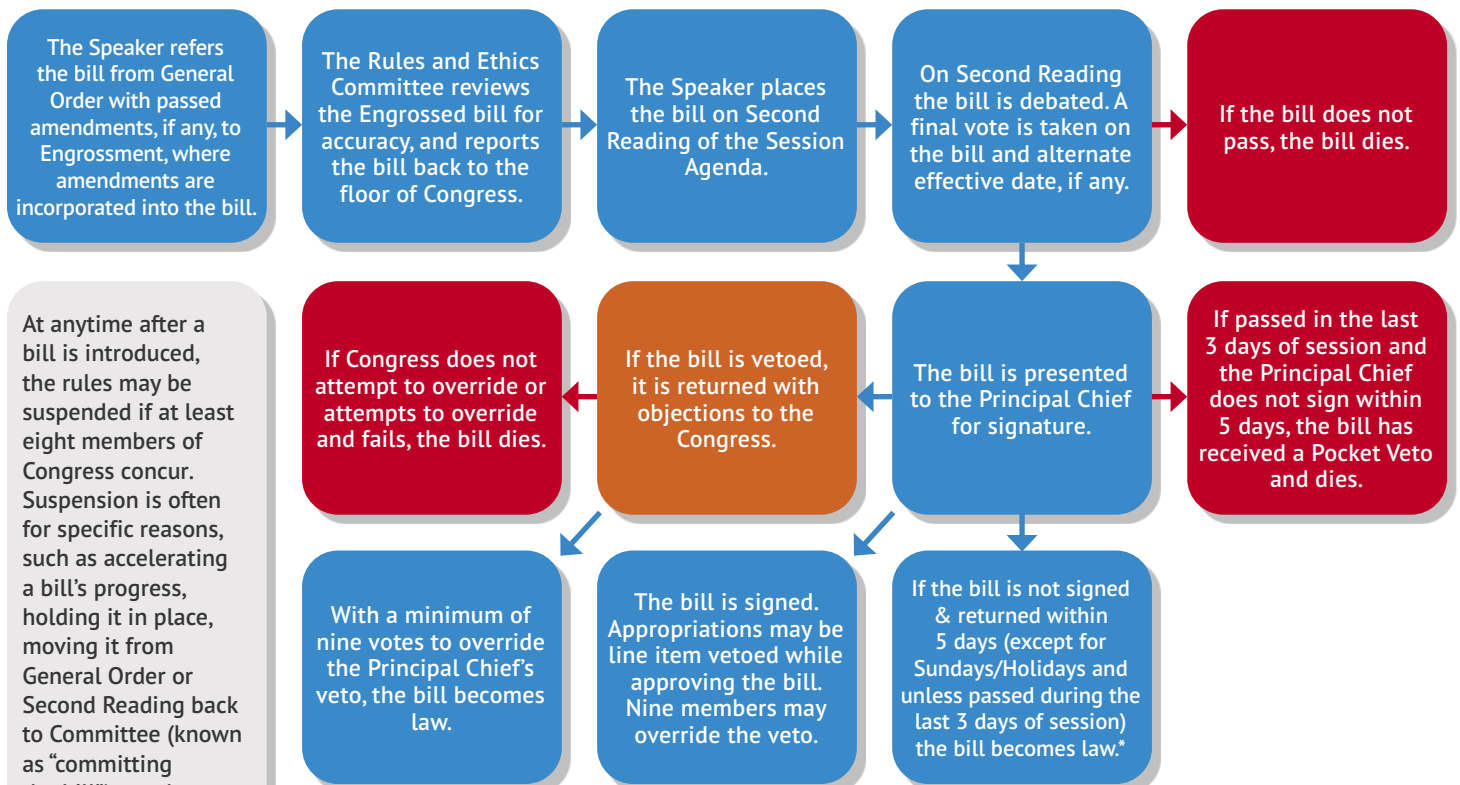
### LEGISLATIVE PROCESS FLOW CHART

- » Prosecute and defend all actions and proceedings, civil or criminal, in the Osage Nation's Trial and Supreme Courts.
- » To give the Principal Chief, the Osage Nation Congress and its Committees formal legal opinions on such matters within the scope of their official duties as they may request from time to time, and to give legal advice to the Boards, Commissions, and Instrumentalities of the Osage Nation government.
- » To institute civil actions against any Osage Nation Officer, Board or Commission Member, for the failure of such Officers or Members to perform their duties as prescribed by the laws and the Constitution.
- » To perform all duties and responsibilities of the office following the highest standards of legal ethics as required of members of the American Bar Association by the ABA Code of Professional Responsibility.
