Chairman Waller states that Kevin Chestnut, Director of Operations of Nucera is here to give a brief update on their status after the devasting Barnsdall tornado. **Mr. Chestnut** states that the plant was in the direct path of the tornado and received maximum damage. They hope to restore around 20% of productivity within a couple of weeks and estimates it will take 12-15 months to restore the other 80%. He notes that they have been able to keep everyone on the payroll to assist with the cleanup. **Councilman Revard** asks about the status of pumping into the Class I well and is told that the area of the plant that feeds into the well is the area that was destroyed.

4. New Business

a. Pipe Disposal - Second Chair Red Eagle

*Councilman Shackelford joins 10:16 am

Second Chair Red Eagle states that guidelines need to be established regarding the sale of pipe and equipment obtained from the well plugging activities as stated in the proposed resolution.

Motion: Authorize OMC staff to manage the pipe and equipment obtained from well plugging activities and to sell or dispose of structural pipe in accordance with ON procurement policies. All equipment deemed beneficial will be retained and made available for rental and OMC geologist will be responsible for tracking and

authorizing the rental of such equipment. Furthermore, all proceeds from the sale or rental will be deposited in the S-510 account and reported to the OMC on a monthly basis by the OMC geologist.

Discussion - Councilman Revard states that he is adamantly opposed to the staff or geologist being involved in the process. He states that they are not qualified and do not know how to keep track of the equipment or market it. He states that he is adamantly opposed to our geologist having anything to do with the equipment and would like a third party or the Osage Nation to prepare the list and provide photographs. He reiterates that he wants no staff or geologist involved. Councilwoman Erwin questions the rental process and procedures. Councilman Bighorse asks if the ON takes pictures before starting projects so that there is some documentation to refer to and is told that they do. Councilwoman Erwin asks that if they don't want our geologist to do this, who will. Councilman Revard states that he would do it before he'd have our geologist go out. He also states that it needs to be sold as is, where is to avoid trucking costs. He states that the OMC could hire someone to do it or just depend on the ON and we needed to start with the ON and get a list of what they have found and pictures and then just deal with it. He also states that when he says we, he means the eight councilmembers only. Second Chair Red Eagle states that we already have inventory on the 86 wells that were plugged by us and calls for the question. Chairman Waller states that the ON is looking at selling it from its location.
